Singer/Comedienne Donna Moore To Unveil Her New Show,
“The Cougar Cabaret..... The Cat is Out of the Bag,”
At Don’t Tell Mama on May 2, 3 and 9

Singer, actress, and comedienne, **Donna Moore**, will introduce her new show, “**The Cougar Cabaret,**” at **Don’t Tell Mama**, 343 West 46th Street, on **Wednesday, May 2, at 9:00 PM, Thursday, May 3, at 8:30 PM, and Wednesday, May 9, at 9:00 PM.** The cabaret musical is the prelude to a full-scale production of “**Cougar, the Musical,**” which Moore and her producers – **Blue Cloud Productions, LLC** and **The StoryLine Project, LLC** -- are planning to present in an Off Broadway theatre in the fall of 2007 or spring of 2008.

Directed by **Robert Brink**, the production features an original music score by **Mark Barkan** and **Donna Moore**. The Music Director is **Steven Borsuk**.

According to Moore, “A **cougar** is an older woman who seeks the pleasurable company of younger men. I view it as a metaphor for female empowerment. She’s overcome sexual taboos and now lives her life to the fullest.” This is a growing phenomenon in our society; the number of women with younger men has soared in the last 25 years from 15% to 30% – consider such bold-faced couples as **Demi Moore** and **Ashton Kutcher**, **Courtney Cox** and **David Arquette**, **Madonna** and **Guy Richie** and longtime companions, **Susan Sarandon** and **Tim Robbins**.

“**The Cougar Cabaret.....**” is a follow-up to Ms. Moore’s highly successful cabaret turn --“**The unBalancing Act**”-- which was a tribute to the human spirit and how one chick has survived the rigors and challenges of life.

Moore describes that earlier show as “Barbie Meets Desperate Housewives on Demi and Ashton’s Lawn” and regards her newest effort, “**The Cougar Cabaret....**” as “a female empowerment musical reflecting what’s happening today in the world of male and female relationships.”
